Idhaya College for Women (Autonomous), Kumbakonam, conducted Students' Union Election On 3rd July 2025 in a democratic process. The election culminated in the successful appointment of the College President, Vice President, General Secretary, and Vice Secretary. Committed to nurturing leadership potential among its students, the institution continually provides extensive opportunities to develop their competencies. Criteria for election were read out by Students' Forum Incharge Mrs.M.Annalakshmi, Assistant Professor of English. The candidates who nominated for election introduced themselves and Rev.Sr.Dr.Eugin Amala, Principal & Chief Electoral Officer wished the students to elect eligible candidates.

Within the college premises, five designated polling stations were established. The Principal served as the Chief Electoral Officer, overseeing the democratic process. A Steering Committee comprising four faculty members ensured the smooth and accessible conduct of the election, while five additional faculty members acted as Booth Level Officers. The Students' Forum in-charge compiled a consolidated list of elected members, organized according to their respective posts. Subsequent to the main election, each department appointed additional ministers and secretaries in alignment with their respective functions. The Cultural Committee selected the Minister and Secretary for Cultural Affairs, while the Sports Club appointed the Minister and Secretary for Sports.
