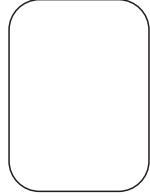

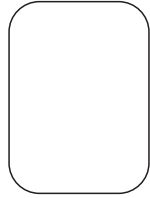

ELIGIBILITY OF ADMISSION

The Candidates who are provisionally selected for admission will be intimated. They have to pay the fees before the due - date. The following should be produced at the time of admission.

- a. Transfer and Conduct Certificate in original.
- b. Tamilnadu Higher Secondary Certificate (or its equivalent certificate in original.
- c. Candidates who have passed an examination other than Tamilnadu Higher Secondary should produce Eligibility Certificate from Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirapalli.
- d. Undergraduates, Post graduates and Research studies from other University and deemed University should furnish an eligibility certificate from Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirapalli.
- e. Ten Passport size photographs (2.5"x2")
- f. Community certificate in original and two photo copies (xerox) attested by a Gazetted Officer.

ADMISSION

Application for U.G. Programmes should be submitted within 10 working days from the publication of the +2 examination results, and for P.G. courses within 10 working days from the publication of the U.G. Examination results of Bharathidasan University. Applications received thereafter may not be considered.

When a Certificate is found to be bogus, admission is liable for cancellation, besides criminal action being taken.

SPECIAL NOTE :

1. The higher secondary mark sheet will be returned only after verification.
2. Admission is subjected to verification of marks certificate by the Director of Government Examinations
3. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
4. Ragging is a serious offence entailing immediate dismissal from the college. Any kind of wild, noisy and disturbing celebrations are strictly forbidden in the college.
5. Student found possessing or using drugs or alcohol and those found peddling drugs will be dismissed from the college.

6. No student is allowed to use mobile phone in the college and in the hostel.
7. If any one of the students discontinues her studies in the middle of the course she has to pay the full Course Fees (For UG 3 Years and PG 2 Years)

RULES AND CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

Each Idhayamite is looked upon as an individual endowed by God with certain talents with her own character and personality which must be developed and perfected. Idhaya looks each of her students to uphold the standard of the college, in and outside, also throughout life.

1. The official **medium of communication in the campus will be ENGLISH.**
2. Identity Cards for all students will be issued soon after their admission into the College. **Every student has to wear her Identity Card every day.** Identity Card is absolutely essential during the examination days and for obtaining Scholarship, Certificates, Library Entry etc.,
3. The students should personally approach the staff members for personal development. Students and staff should expressively avoid doing anything by word and deed which may disturb the unity and harmony of life both in the college and hostel.
4. The authorities of the management are directly incharge of the integral formation of the students. Students should make use of this opportunity to get all the guidance needed.
5. **Students should maintain cleanliness and safeguard the properties of the institution.**

DRESS CODE: Staff and Students are expected to be neatly dressed in accordance with rules of approved decency and modesty. Every first Monday and on celebration days staff and students are expected to come in uniform. Leggings, Net Shawl, Short Tops, T.Shirt and Jeans are not allowed. During the festival special permission will be given to wear Sarees and half Sarees.

ATTENDANCE

1. **For all students, attendance as prescribed by the Bharathidasan University, Trichirappalli (75%)** and also by the College is quite essential and the College emphasises on the attendance of every student to have a maximum number of working days. **No student shall be absent from the college without proper leave letter. Application for leave must be made before hand on information to the Principal and the same should be countersigned by the Parent / Guardian and recommended by the concerned staff member incharge of the class through the H.O.D. Leave application for the Hostellers should bear the recommendation of the Deputy Warden of the hostel.**
2. Only if the absence is due to unforeseen circumstances and if the leave has been availed, the application for leave must be submitted as early as possible, i.e., **the next working day.**
3. If a student is late for an hour she will not be admitted inside the class unless she produces the Hand Book with the **'Late Entry'** to the class teacher.
4. Attendance will be taken at **the beginning of every period.** A student who is not in the class when the attendance is taken will be **marked absent.**
5. A student requiring leave from a class or a portion of a class must **apply for it in person** to the Class-in-charge of the class. If she wishes to leave the college she should meet the Principal or the Head of department and get her consent. If she is a hosteller she should get the **consent of the Warden.**
6. **No leave will be granted during Internal Exams and University Exams.** In case of serious illness, a **medical certificate is to be produced signed by the Govt. Recognised Doctor.**
7. **Attendance for all association meetings, and college functions are binding on both staff and students.**
8. **Staff and students must be present on the re-opening day and on the last working day.**

DISCIPLINE

1. Students should greet the Principal and other superiors and members of the faculty when they meet them for the first time during the day and should stand aside to let them pass.
2. Discipline is the hall mark of character and hence our top most priority is on **discipline** which, if strictly adhered to, will automatically enable every student to be good in studies as well. Discipline essentially depends upon two factors.
 - (i) implicit obedience to the prescribed rules
 - (ii) faithfulness to the institution.
3. The cleanliness of the college building and surrounding should be the personal responsibility of every student. Therefore no marks should be made on the walls or desks. No Paper should be thrown on the floor.
4. **At the ringing of the first bell all the students are expected to be inside their respective class room** and with the entrance of the staff member into the class room all the students should stand up and greet the staff. All the students should respond to the call of attendance which will be taken every hour.
5. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel her from the institution.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

A sound body is the place for a sound mind. Every student is required to undergo the course of physical training prescribed by the college, and her annual attendance and progress certificates shall not be considered complete unless the Principal has certified to the effect that the candidates have in addition to the usual course of instruction satisfactorily undergone the prescribed course of physical training and put in three fourth of the attendance. The course of physical training to be prescribed by the college and certified by the Principal may include field sports, games and exercises.

2. Intramural games and sports are conducted and talented **players will be encouraged** to participate in the Inter - Collegiate and Interuniversity sports and games and bring laurels to the College.
3. Certificate of attendance will be given to such candidates who represent the College at such Interuniversity and Inter Collegiate games, subject to the condition that their periodical test, exam and general academic progress are not affected.

SCHOLARSHIP

Government of Tamilnadu is offering a few scholarships to some deserving students based upon the economic criteria. Students of minority communities (Catholic & Muslim) receive their scholarships with the help of the Management.

1. SC/ST students including the Christian converts are eligible to apply for scholarship offered by the Tamil Nadu Government provided their parent's annual income does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/-.
2. Farmer's children scholarship can also be availed by students whose parents hold the Farmer's Social Security and welfare Card issued by Tamil Nadu Government.
3. The student can apply for scholarship / concession only after paying the first semester fees in full. The necessary application forms are available in the college office. In addition, the college also provides concession to the deserving students.
4. Scholarships amount will be distributed to the concerned applicant, when it is sanctioned by the Government and the funds are received from the Government, which will be intimated at the appropriate time.

THE LIBRARY

The Library is open to all members of the college on **every working day from 8.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.** Students should visit the library frequently and do intelligent reading and reference work without neglecting general good reading.

Rules:

1. The Library tokens are meant for personal use.
2. Only one book is permitted for a card.
3. Exchange of book is not permitted.
4. The Library offers the open access system.
5. Library users should sign in the gate entry register.
6. Return the book on time and renew the date which is necessary.
7. Use the library during lunch time and leisure hours.
8. Use the reference books and take photo copy (xerox) within the library if necessary.
9. For the late submission of books the student will be penalised with Rs10/-per day.
10. Strict silence shall be observed in the library.
11. No member shall take any printed book or notebook into the library
12. Periodicals placed in magazine racks should not be mishandled. They should be replaced on the racks after use.
13. Reference books and periodicals will not be issued but are available for reference within the library.
14. No staff or student is allowed to lend books to anyone in or outside the college.
15. Library books will not be lent to either students or staff during vacation.
16. Books when you use, must always be covered. They should not be left about in the verandah or in class.

The Library accepts donation of books from individuals, societies & Institutions. Such donations once accepted shall be the absolute property of the college. Books donated by the students are maintained in the Book Bank of the Library.

CERTIFICATE

A student past or present, desiring to obtain a certificate (transfer, conduct, etc.,) shall apply for it in the prescribed form available in the college office. **The application should be submitted along with a search fee of Rs. 10/-**

⇒ **Certificates will not generally be issued at less than 48 hours of notice.**

⇒ No duplicate copy of transfer certificate will be issued.

⇒ A fee of Rs.10 will be charged for each typed, certified **copy** of certificates.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF INTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

There will be three centralized Internal Exams for each course in a semester. First two exams will be of one and half hours and last Model Exam will be of three hours duration.

Absentees for Internal Exams

If a student is not able to write the Internal Exams because of her participation in an important event related to NSS / Games / Sports representing the college or university the students has to get the prior permission of the Principal through the proper channel request should be submitted to the Head of the Department at the earliest & complete the exam within 7 days.

IDHAYA HOSTEL

1. The Idhaya Hostel is under the direct control of the college authorities who will act as **'Loco parents'** to all the residence.
2. Students those who are seeking admission must produce medical fitness certificate signed by a registered Doctor.
3. Students found **guilty of insubordination, theft or insincerity will be summarily dismissed** especially when a timely warning has proven ineffective. Similarly students forming themselves into cliques dangerous to good discipline will be expelled.
4. **Hostellers can not ordinarily leave the hostel on weekend holidays.** They are admitted into the hostel on the understanding that they will study hard and as such should **utilize the week-end holidays for this purpose**, but they are freely permitted to go home for terminal holidays.
5. **Parents or guardians may visit the students once in a month, (i.e) on the Fourth Sunday.**
6. No student may be called to the parlour **during college hours** except with the permission of the Principal.
7. Students living in the hostel shall be under the disciplinary supervision of the Warden and her assistants. They may freely approach them for help.
